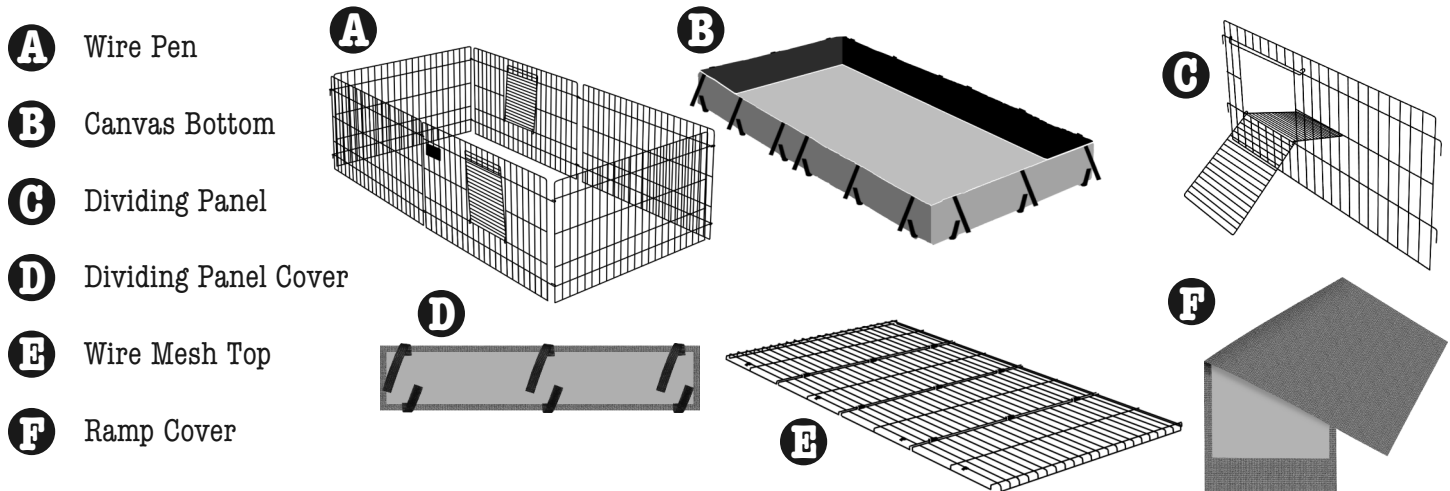


Assembly Instructions for 171GHP

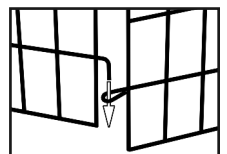
1. Please save sales receipt as proof of purchase for warranty purposes.

Assembly Instructions

- 1** Connect the two ends of the pen by sliding the hooks on the end of pen through the loops on the other end of the pen. The top hook is longer than the bottom hook allowing the top hook to be partially inserted while lining up the bottom hook.

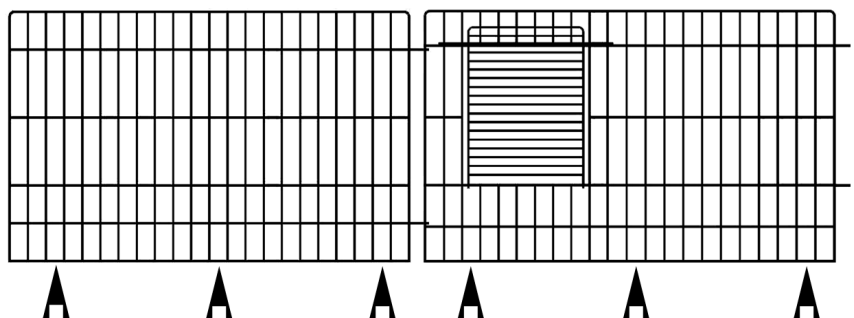


Note: If assembling pen for use as single unit, configure so doors open outward. If assembling for use as add-on, configure so doors open inward to be used as ramp between pens.

- 2** Set up pen in rectangular configuration.
- 3** Open Canvass Bottom with Velcro straps on the outside. Lay the Canvas Bottom inside the assembled pen.



- 4** Attach the Velcro strap to the pen in the noted locations. Wrap the lower strap underneath the bottom wire, and the upper strap over the top of the fourth wire from the top.

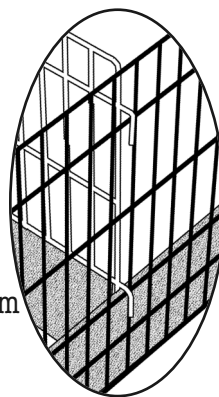


5 Attach the Velcro strap to the pen in the noted locations below. Wrap the lower strap underneath the bottom wire, and the upper strap over the top of the fourth wire from the top.

6 Locate the Dividing Panel and the Dividing Panel Cover.

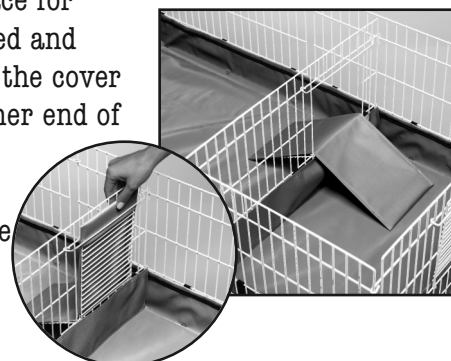
Suggestion: MidWest discovered that by keeping food, water and treats in a contained area of the Habitat, guinea pigs will tend to “do their business” in that same area. At the same time, you will use a fraction of the bedding. The Dividing Panel will set that barrier. The Cover will keep the bedding from going through the wires and also help keep the wires from getting dirty.

7 Attach the Cover to the Dividing Panel by wrapping the lower strap underneath the bottom wire, and the upper strap over the top of the next wire up. Attach the cover so that the Velcro strips face inward toward the section you intend to use as the care area.



8 Locate the ramp cover. (The ramp cover provides an appropriate surface for access from the play area to the care area. One side of the ramp can be raised and locked in the up position to contain your pet while cleaning.) Slip one end of the cover over one end of one of the ramps. Lift the ramps up together and slip the other end of the cover over the other ramp.

9 Insert the Dividing Panel into Habitat securing it in place by placing the hooks of the Dividing Panel over the second wire from the top and the third wire from the bottom. Attach the other end to the corresponding opening.

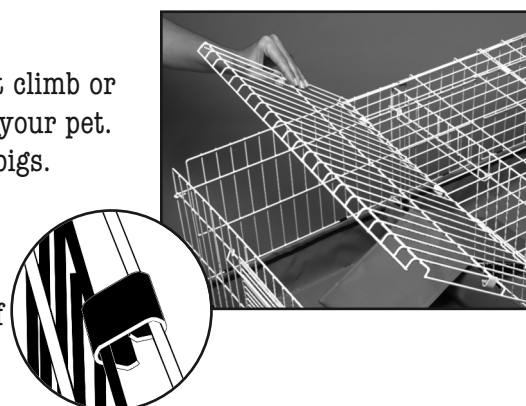


Suggestion: MidWest found that allowing approximately 1/3 of the Habitat for the care area is ideal.

10 Locate the Wire Mesh Top.

Suggestion: MidWest takes advantage of the fact that guinea pigs don't climb or jump by using an open top environment allowing easy interaction with your pet. Be cautious with other animals or small children accessing the guinea pigs. Install the top panel if you feel it is necessary.

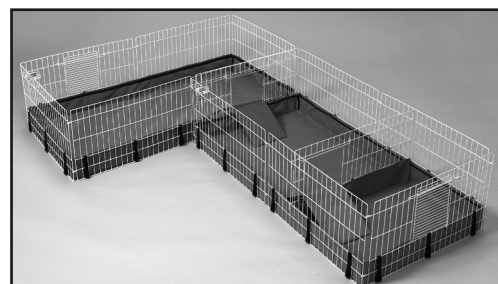
11 Lay Top on assembled pen with the bent edges on the outside of the pen. To secure the top, latch the attached clips over the top wire of the Pen.



Washing Instructions & Options

When necessary, hand wash the Canvas Bottom, the Dividing Panel Cover and the Ramp Cover with water and mild detergent and dry flat. Machine washing is not recommended.





Any combination of MidWest's Guinea Habitat and Guinea Habitat Plus can be joined together to provide even more play area for your guinea pig. Set up the pen so the doors open inward. Align to opening with the opening of the other Habitat. Use a MidWest Guinea Habitat Ramp Cover (Model 171GHPRC) to secure the pens together and also provide a suitable surface. Either ramp can be raised and locked in place to contain your pet on one side while cleaning the other side.



Guinea Pig Care

Guinea Pig Needs

1. Spacious cage: Experts agree that space (square footage) is the most important point when housing a guinea pig.

2. Food: Guinea pig food pellet should make up most of the diet. Feed twice daily (morning, night) Offer small amounts of fresh fruits and vegetables. Clean up leftover food so it doesn't spoil. Note: Guinea pigs can't store or manufacture vitamin C. If the food pellets don't contain vitamin C, a section of orange or other fruits and vegetables high in vitamin C should be added to the diet.)

3. Treats & Chews: Hard, crunchy treats and chews help keep the ever-growing teeth trimmed.

4. Hayrack: Make Timothy hay available at all times (Note: Hay aids in their digestion.)

5. Heavy food dishes

6. Water bottle: Make clean, fresh water available at all times.

7. Hiding house/tube: Guinea pigs like to hide when they are playing and also when they are startled.

8. Bedding: Paper product bedding designed for guinea pigs, aspen or kiln-dried pine shavings.

Guinea Pig “No-No’s”

1. Cedar and raw pine (not kiln-dried) shavings: These contain oils which can contribute to respiratory problems. Sawdust and cat litter should also not be used due possible inhalation or eating.

2. Litter boxes: not normally used

3. Exercise wheels & exercise balls: these are very bad for guinea pigs and can cause crippling injuries to their back, feet, and toes

4. Expanding a cage upward to increase square footage: experts recommend a one level living area

Guinea Pig Tips and Facts

1. Lift and hold you guinea pig firmly but gently.

2. Place the Guinea Habitat in a dry area with constant temperature (65° - 75°) out of direct sunlight & drafts.

3. Remove soiled bedding and spot clean daily.

4. Clean the Habitat weekly.

5. Search the internet for additional information on the proper care for guinea pigs or “cavies”...a common name for guinea pigs from the scientific name Cavia.

A. The purchaser must call MIDWEST's HELPLINE, 800-428-8560, to report the alleged defect to a customer service representative or obtain missing parts.

B. The customer service representative will determine if the defect is covered by this warranty, and if it is, will authorize and instruct the purchaser in how to obtain corrective action.

C. MIDWEST may require the purchaser to present the sales receipt or other proof of purchase prior to authorizing any return or replacement. No returns or replacements will be permitted without proper authorization. If a return or replacement is authorized, you may be requested to return the item to MIDWEST or to make the item available for pick-up by MIDWEST.
