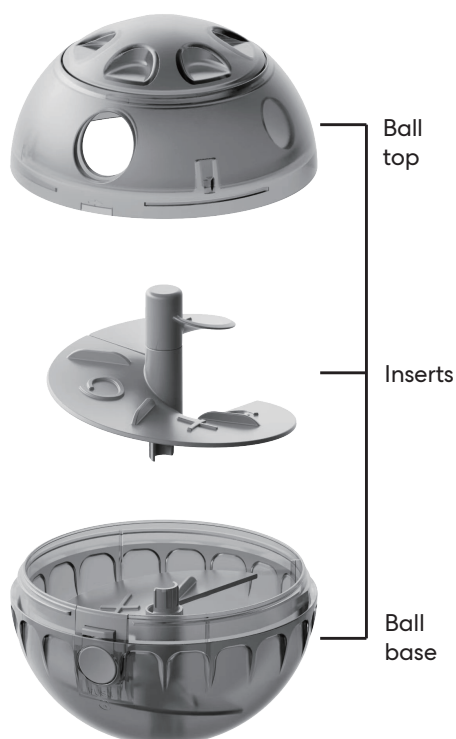


Assembly Instructions

- A challenging way to promote mental activity, increase critical thinking skills, and reward with treats.
- Watch your dog nudge, roll, paw and chase the ball to release the treats inside.
- Great way to beat doggy boredom and can also be used as a slow feeder.
- This toy is recommended for medium to large breed dogs. It is not a chew toy. The ball should be larger than your dog's mouth.

Components:



How to Use:

1. Press and hold the button, while rotating the top of the ball to open.
2. Remove each insert by pulling up with moderate force. There are a total of 2 inserts that can be removed.
3. Fill the ball base with your dog's favorite treats or kibble.
4. Re-install the inserts based on your desired difficulty level. The more inserts that are added, the more difficult it will be for treats to dispense.
5. Before re-assembling the ball, rotate the ball top to adjust the hole opening as needed.
6. Re-assemble by placing the ball top on the ball base and twisting until secure. The hole opening and button should be aligned.

To Adjust Difficulty:

Rotate ball top to adjust the size of the hole opening.



Largest opening (easiest) ▶ ▶ ▶ Smallest opening (most difficult)

***Choose treats that are small enough to fit through the hole opening.**

Warning & Cautions:

Keep out of reach of children. This is not a chew toy. The ball should be larger than your dog's mouth. For use only with medium and large breed dogs. Supervise your pet when using since small parts can present a choking hazard or internal blockage. Discontinue use if the toy is damaged. No dog toy is truly indestructible, so always remove the toy from playtime if pieces begin to break off.

Care Instructions:

Hand wash in warm soapy water. Dry before use.
