Thank you for purchasing the Universal Pet Travel Rear Bike Mount by K&H Pet Products. This product is designed to hold both the K&H Travel Bike Basket for Pets and the K&H Travel Bike Backpack for Pets (both sold separately). When used properly, this product should provide you and your pet years of comfortable and easy travel together.



ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:


- Take the product out of the box and lay all pieces on a flat surface. See Figure 1.
- To install your K&H Universal Pet Travel Rear Bike Mount, first locate the sheet of black rubber material and wrap it around the seat post of your bike below the seat. Mark the spot where the two rubber ends would meet once cut. The rubber guard will need to fully cover your seat post so mark accordingly before cutting. Now use scissors or a utility knife to cut the excess rubber off where you marked it. See Figure 2. Set the sized piece aside for later.
- Locate the black metal rear mount piece and begin to rotate the quick-release silver lever to slightly loosen the bolt from the adjacent locking nut. See Figure 3a. Do not completely unscrew. Unscrew just enough until the quick-release lever, the bolt, and washer release from the open channel on the black clamp located on the bike mount piece. See Figure 3b.
- Once the lever, bolt, and washer are released from the black clamp you can now open the clamp in order to fit it around your bike's seat post. See Figure 4.
- Place the clamp around your seat post without tightening it, making sure there is approximately an inch clearance between the top of your back tire and the bottom of the rear bike mount. Once you've found the correct placement, mark a spot on the bike seat post with a pencil at the top and bottom of the black clamp. This will determine where you will place the rubber guard strip before you clamp the bike mount to your seat post. See Figure 5a & 5b.
- Lay the rear mount aside and remove the backing from the rubber guard strip to expose the side with adhesive. Place the sticky side against the bike seat post between the two pencil marks made earlier and press firmly all the way around the seat post to adhere. Do not overlap rubber strip. Trim a bit off the end if necessary. See Figure 6.
- Next, place the clamp once again around the bike seat post so that it overlaps the now attached rubber guard strip. Make sure to center the clamp vertically over the rubber guard strip. Squeeze the clamp closed. See Figure 7.
- Hold the rear bike mount into position so that it overlaps the rubber protection strip on the seat post and the horizontal support bar of the bike mount is in-line with your back tire. While holding in place, make sure the silver lever containing the bolt and the washer are in the correct position. The black side of the round washer should be snug up against the bottom of the silver quickrelease lever. See Figure 8.
- Holding the bolt and washer together, rotate them forward towards the open channel in the black clamp. Still keeping them together, slide the bolt into the open channel. Only the bolt will end up being seated in the channel while the washer and lever remain on the outside of the black clamp. **OVER** See Figure 9a and 9b. Continued...



TIP: If using the K&H Bike Basket, tuck the unused black straps underneath the basket's gray cover to keep them clear of your bike's back tire. These straps are only used for the K&H front mounting bike system. See Figure 11 b.

If attaching the K&H Bike Backpack, undo the hook and loop strap on the bottom of the backpack before placing it onto the rear mount. See Figure **12a.** Slide the vertical bar of the bike mount into the sturdy opening on the rear of the backpack. See Figure 12b. Push the product down until it's resting on the horizontal metal support bar of the rear bike mount. Next, pull the hook and loop strap on the bottom of the backpack tightly underneath the horizontal support bar of the bike mount and fasten it to the hook and loop material on the other side to secure it. See Figure 12c. This will tightly hold the Bike Backpack to the rear bike mount.

TIP: If using the K&H Bike Backpack, tuck the shoulder straps into the two open pockets on the back side of the backpack to keep them out of the way and clear of your back tire. See Figure 12d.

Lastly, attach the leads located on the inside, bottom of your bike basket or backpack to your pet's collar or harness to keep them inside and secure at all times.

Congratulations! You and your furry friend are now ready to hit the bike path or cruise around town using your new K&H Universal Pet Travel Rear Bike Mount. Happy and safe riding together!
