


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



STEP 1 Unfold the **Front** panel. **Tip**: It's the one with the door. Unfold the **Back** panel opposite the front panel.



STEP 2 Holding the **Front** panel up, unfold the **Left** panel and connect it with the **Front** panel using the built-in hook.



STEP 3 Lift the **Back** panel and connect it to the **Left** panel. Unfold the **Right** panel and connect it to the **Front** and **Back** panels.



STEP 4 Unfold the **Top** panel and place it over the house, making sure the door lock is facing out. Check that the panel is centered lengthwise and connect with **built-in hooks**.

KEEP IT TOGETHER


Make sure to secure the **Top** panel with the built-in hooks on each side.

There are a total of **4 hooks** to lock the panel in place.









STEP 5 Locate the 4 built-in Spring Hooks at the top of the Front and Back panels.




STEP 6 Lift the Spring Hook and hook the wire on the Top panel with the **Spring Hook**. Then lower the Spring Hook and push it down to secure in place. Repeat this step for all 4 Spring Hooks.

INSTALL THE WHEELS




STEP 1 Remove the Pan and have the Screws and Wheels handy. Oh, and pat yourself on the back for being almost done with building your pet's next favorite abode.



STEP 2 Place the house on its side to make it easy to install the wheels.



STEP 3 You'll need a Phillips screwdriver for this step. Thread a screw through a washer (3a), then through one of the iron plates on the Bottom panel (3b). Next, grab a wheel (3c) and thread the screw through the iron plate on the wheel (3d). Finally, secure in place with another washer and nut (3e-f).
























STEP 4 Repeat Step 3 for all 4 wheels.




STEP 5 Set the house back down with wheels on the ground. Slide the **Pan** back through the slot under the cage.

HOW TO USE THE DOOR LOCKS

This crate has two doors. One on the Top panel and one on the Front panel.



TOP PANEL DOOR Unlock by lifting the lock handle and sliding it up. To lock the door, close it and then slide the lock handle down until it inserts in the loop.



FRONT PANEL DOOR Unlock by lifting the lock handle and sliding it to the lef. To lock the door, close it, then slide the lock handle to the right and push it down.

MAINTENANCE

Wipe clean with a damp soft cloth and mild soap. Dry thoroughly. Do not use abrasive cleaners as it may damage the wire coating.

WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ For small pet use only. NOT FOR USE BY CHILDREN.
- Be sure to choose the correct sizing for your pet based on wire spacing, size and pet type.
- Give the house a look over periodically and do not use if you see any excessive wear or damage.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Remove your pet's collar or any pet accessory before putting them in the house.
- Since many small pets can jump high and/or scale wire bars, always supervise your pet when they're in the house. Even if your pet isn't known to be an escape artist, it's a good idea to place the house in a room that has been pet-proofed.
- Pet-proofing includes taking measures to ensure your small pet cannot chew or ingest electrical cords, toxic plants, carpets, furniture, and that they can't squeeze into gaps behind furniture or appliances.
- · Not recommended for large animals such as dogs, cats, and other larger pets.
- · Do not use as a barrier or gate.

- Never place your pet's house in direct sunlight or store your house outside or in a car, because the metal can become very hot.
- Assemble according to the directions and do not leave your pet in the house for an extended period without supervision.
- Take some time to get your pet used to their crate. It will go a long ways to keeping them happy and comfy inside.
