Step 4

Flip the bed over and place all 4 feet on a flat surface. Use the Allen wrench to tighten all 4 screws. Keep the Allen wrench in a safe place for tightening as needed in the future.







Assembly Instructions

Your pup's new "throne" comes together in just a few steps.

Step 1



SMALL & MEDIUM BED

SMALL AND MEDIUM BEDS ONLY:

Place the mat flat on the floor with the pockets for the frame facing up. Insert each of the 4 metal feet (parts B & C) into the longer side pockets with the indented hole facing down and feet facing out. Once inside the pockets, connect the tapered end of (B) with the open end of (C). Continue to the next page, STEP 2.


LARGE BED ONLY:

Place the mat flat on the floor with the pockets for the frame facing up.

First, connect the tapered end of (B) to an open end of (E).


Second, insert (E) into the longer side pockets with the indented hole of (B) facing down and feet facing out.

Third, insert the tapered end of (C) into the opposite end of the pocket and connect to the open end of (E) with the indented hole facing down and feet facing out. Repeat for the second, longer side pocket.



Step 2


Insert each of the metal cross bars (D) into a short side pocket.



Step 3

Rotate the metal feet upwards so the indented holes are facing out. Align the ends of the cross bars (D) with the interior holes of the metal feet. Use the supplied Allen wrench to insert screws, do not fasten all the way (completely tightening will make it difficult to align the second side).

Repeat for the remaining side.
